### Underlying Causes of First World War Dominoes

### Developed by Erica Field

### Theme: WW1 Age range: 11+

### Context:

This dominoes activity helps students to gain an understanding of the underlying causes of the First World War exploring how certain aspects and causes of the war had more effect than others. The game is designed to raise discussion and to encourage more varied responses.

### **Preparation:**

Print out the A<sub>4</sub> sheets. If possible, cover the sheets of Domino cards, "Sentence Openers" and "Connectives" with 'clear pvc self adhesive book cover film' before cutting them up.

### HOW TO PLAY:

Play in groups of two or three.

Deal out all the dominoes. Move clockwise around the circle and fit the words. When you place your domino next to another domino you have to explain why they fit together. Think carefully about your explanation. Try using one of these "Connective" or "Sentence Openers" in your explanation. If you do not have the correct domino, move onto the next player.

Continue working round the group until one player has finished.

The winner is the first player to have no dominoes left.

#### Learning Outcomes:

Students will be able to discuss the underlying causes of WW1 and demonstrate their understanding through linking together some of the issues. If you have found further learning outcomes please share them by emailing collaborate@mantralingua.com.
