Preparation:

HOW TO PLAY:

You need four players, one Game Board and two sets of cards (different colour borders).


- 1. Work with a partner to make a team of two.
- 2. Shuffle your team cards and place them in a pile facing down.
- 3. Take turns to turn over your top card and decide where to put it on the board. Everyone has to agree that the card fits the picture.
- 4. The team with the first four cards in a line either vertically, horizontally or diagonally wins.
