
Push, pull or push and pull

Push, pull or push and pull Sorting Activity

Theme: Forces Age range: 5+

Context:

Identifying and classifying are important parts of all the sciences and here we have devised a fun way for younger children to start learning these processes.

Preparation:

Print out the A₄ sheets.

If possible, laminate the Venn Diagrams after joining the two sides together.

Cover the three 'activity card' pages with 'clear pvc self adhesive book cover film'. Then cut out the squares to make the cards.

We have also provided a blank sheet for you to make your own activity cards.

HOW TO PLAY:

This sorting activity can be done either in groups of three or four or as a whole class activity. (If the children are young it adds to their understanding of the various forces used if they physically have to follow the instructions on the cards.)

If working in groups then each group is given some of the activity cards and a Venn diagram. The children look at each of the instructions on the activity cards and decide where to place them on the Venn diagram. Encourage the children to discuss how they came to their conclusions.
