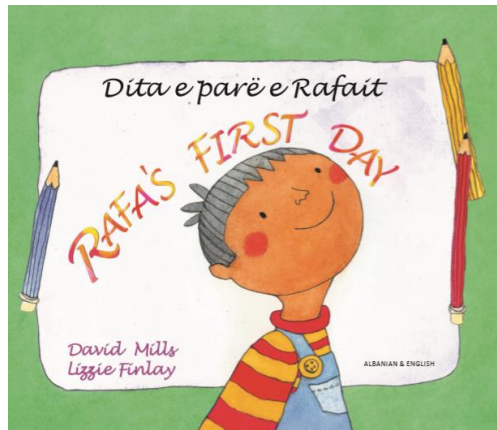


## Rafa's First Day – Asking Questions



Rafa is excited about his first day at school. He takes part in lots of interesting activities. This game is designed to encourage children to ask questions about activities Rafa takes part in and to think about if they enjoy doing them.

The game uses a speaking frame to help the children create their question.

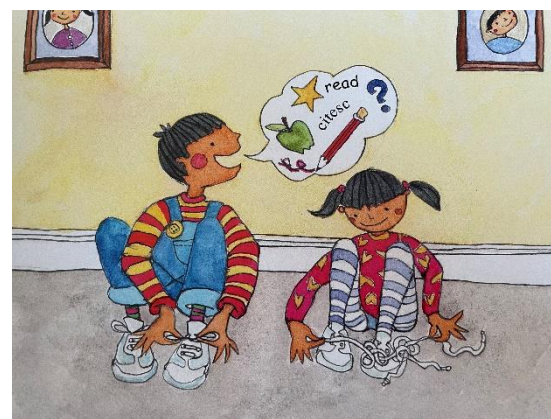
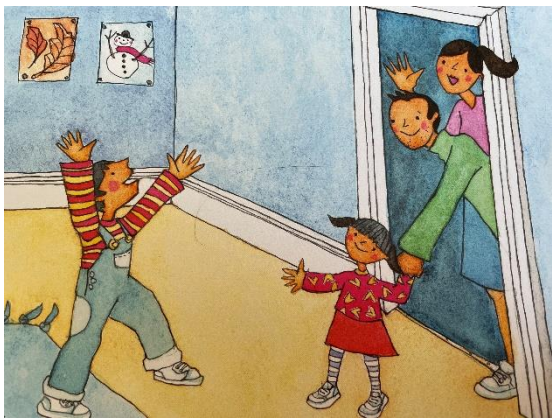
Rafa likes to \_\_\_\_\_. Do you like to \_\_\_\_\_?

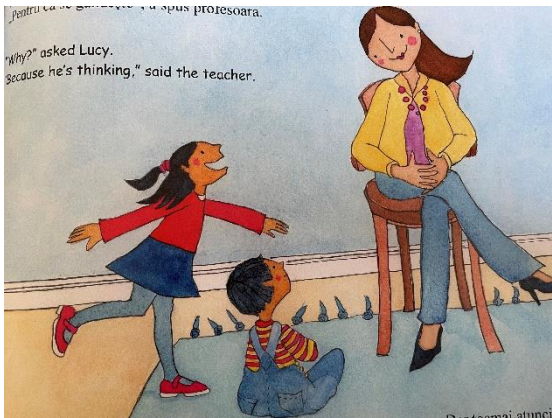
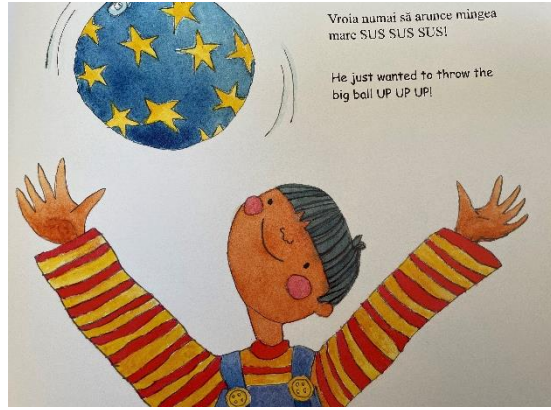
Each player asks his or her question to every person playing. This gives them the opportunity to ask the question more than once if there are more than two players.

The game can be played with two, three or four players.

You can rehearse the speaking frame with the children before the game starts. There are three speaking frames for you to choose from.
